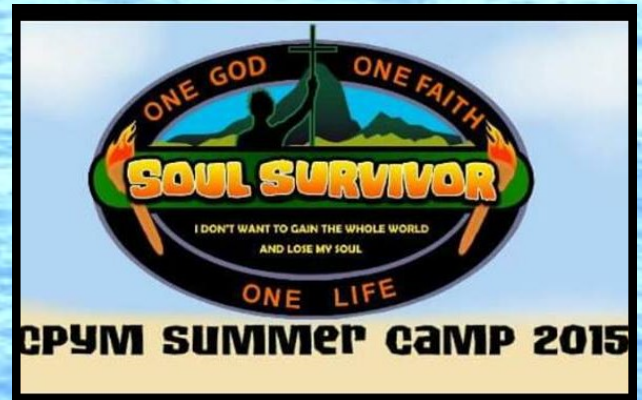
A great story from our camp went like this. A male counselor related his experience to me.
