Special Leadership Seminar available

Leadership!

We all talk about it yet we do very little to develop real leaders for the work of the Master. This year's Impact hopes to help you develop the leadership potential that exists in your church.

Dr. Rich Brown, from Liberty University, will be conducting a special 2 part seminar at Impact 2019. The seminar is titled **“Developing Leaders for the Church”**, and is by invite only. We are asking youth group leaders to hand pick only their juniors, seniors and young adults, who they feel have leadership potential. We expect the seminar to fill up quickly so begin now to think about who you want to be trained in leadership skills.

In this seminar, we will look into three questions: What is leadership? Who is a leader? And What is the difference between a positional leader and an influential leader? We will look into the life of “Two Saul’s” – King Saul and the Apostle Paul and how one failed in leadership while he had the title but the other succeeded while he led from influence. Finally, we will take a look into 1 Timothy 4:12 to see the five needed areas of influential leadership.”

In 2003, Dr. Brown transitioned from serving as Pastor of Student Ministries to become Associate Professor within the Department of Church Ministries at his alma-mater, Liberty University. It is in this context of mentoring, equipping, and teaching the next generation of youth ministry leaders where he ministers to the college students God has placed in his life. Along with his residential teaching responsibilities, he also teaches online to adult learners. He has developed a number of youth ministry courses, including published work texts and co-authored “Student Ministry Essentials” (Moody Press). In addition he serves in the Center for Youth Ministries of Liberty University as the Faculty Director of YouthQuest (traveling ministry team) as well as speaks in a variety of ministry venues. He and his wife are quite active in their local church where he also volunteers as his church’s Director of Student Ministries.

Rich’s interests are quite varied as he is passionate about coffee, baseball, landscaping projects, and anything historical. But most of all, he loves to teach God’s Word in the context of training leaders and encouraging the church to fulfill the Great Commission among adolescents.
